What is a smart city?

- A municipality that uses Internet of Things (IoT) technology to improve government efficiency, better communicate with residents, and improve their lives.

Smart cities impact three main areas:

- Mobility
- Open data
- Smart buildings/infrastructure



What smart cities do:

- Gather and analyze data about how the city works
- Improve operations
- Provide better, personalized services to residents
- Improve residents' health
- Improve sustainability and energy efficiency
