# Check Your iOS

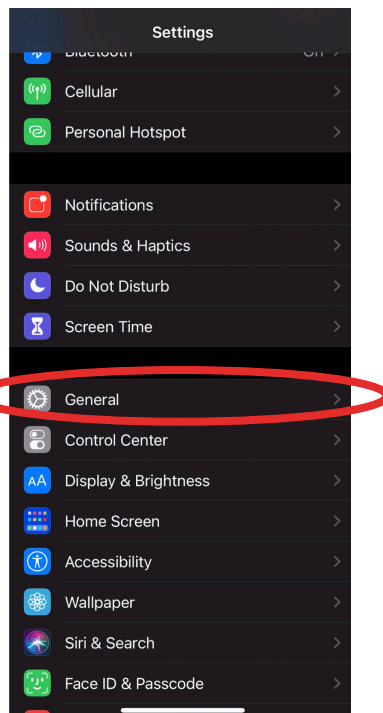


The **operating system** is the software that powers your phone. On iPhones, this is called **iOS**. Updates to the iOS are periodically released. If you ignore nudges from your phone to update your operating system, over time, you may run into issues with the apps on your phone. Many apps require that your phone run an up-to-date iOS. Here's how to check what iOS is running on your phone.

**1** To get started, tap the **Settings** icon on your phone.



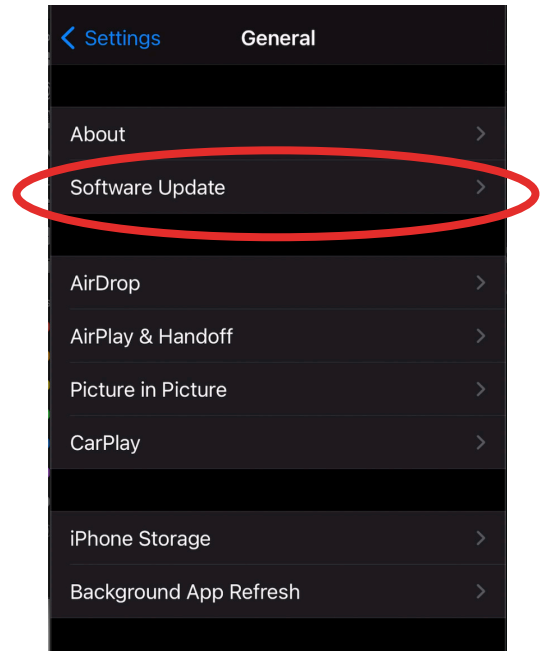
**2** From the Settings menu, tap **General**.

- 3 From the General menu, tap **Software Update**. You'll see this option near the top of the screen.



- 4 If your iOS is up-to-date, you'll see a screen like the image on the left. If your iOS needs to be updated, you'll see a screen prompting you to update it like in the image on the right. Tap **Download and Install** to update your iOS.
