## **Resume Content**

### Do include:

- A brief candidate profile with core skills
- Mobile number
- Professional email address
- Link to LinkedIn profile
- Relevant links to social media
- Link to website or portfolio, if applicable

### Don't include:

- Objective statement
- Graduation dates
- Experience not directly related to the job you're applying for
- Landline number
- Email address with nickname or outdated email provider
