


Getting Started with your iPad

Anatomy of the iPad







The Home Screen and Gestures

Your home screen is your starting point! To get there, press the home button

(shown on page 1).

The **status bar** (highlighted in the image on the right) includes some important symbols:



WiFi: Connect to WiFi to use the internet without a data plan.



Shows how much **battery** is left



Cellular data: if your iPad has a data plan, you'll see this symbol. You can use the internet without WiFi.

TAP: Lightly tap the screen to open an app

or to select an option on screen.

SWIPE: Move one finger horizontally across

the screen to go to the next screen.

SCROLL: To see other parts of the screen, move one finger up or down the screen without stopping.

Apps

App is short for "application" and is a small software program that lets you to "do things."



Download more apps in the App Store. (You need an Apple ID to do this.)



Safari is the iPad's web browser. Open this app to explore the internet!
