### Make Your Own

#### BACON, EGG and CHEESE (BEC)

- 1 bagel (you choose- everything, whole wheat, plain)
- 3 tablespoons butter, divided
- 2 slices of bacon, cooked
- 2 eggs
- 2 slices of American cheese
- Salt and freshly ground pepper to taste
- 1.Pre heat cast iron pan over medium heat and toast the bagels until golden brown. Reserve.
- 2.Add the remaining tablespoon of butter and, once melted, crack both eggs into the pan. As soon as the whites start to set, puncture the yolks and gently spread them over the whites. Season with salt and pepper.
- 3. Layer the cheese and the bacon on top of one the eggs and flip the other egg on top of the bacon. Cook for 20 seconds to melt the cheese.
- 4. Once the cheese has melted, transfer the eggs to the bagel bottom and top with the bagel top.
- 5. Serve immediately or wrap for a on-the-go breakfast!

#### THE PERFECT MANHATTAN COCKTAIL

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 2 ounces bourbon or rye whiskey
- 1 ounce sweet vermouth
- 2 or 3 dashes aromatic bitters
- Preserved cherry, for garnish

#### DIRECTIONS:

- 1.Chill a cocktail glass.
- 2. Half fill a cocktail shaker with ice.
- 3.Add the whiskey, vermouth, and bitters.
- 4.Stir well.
- 5. Strain into the glass.
- 6.Add the cherry and serve.
