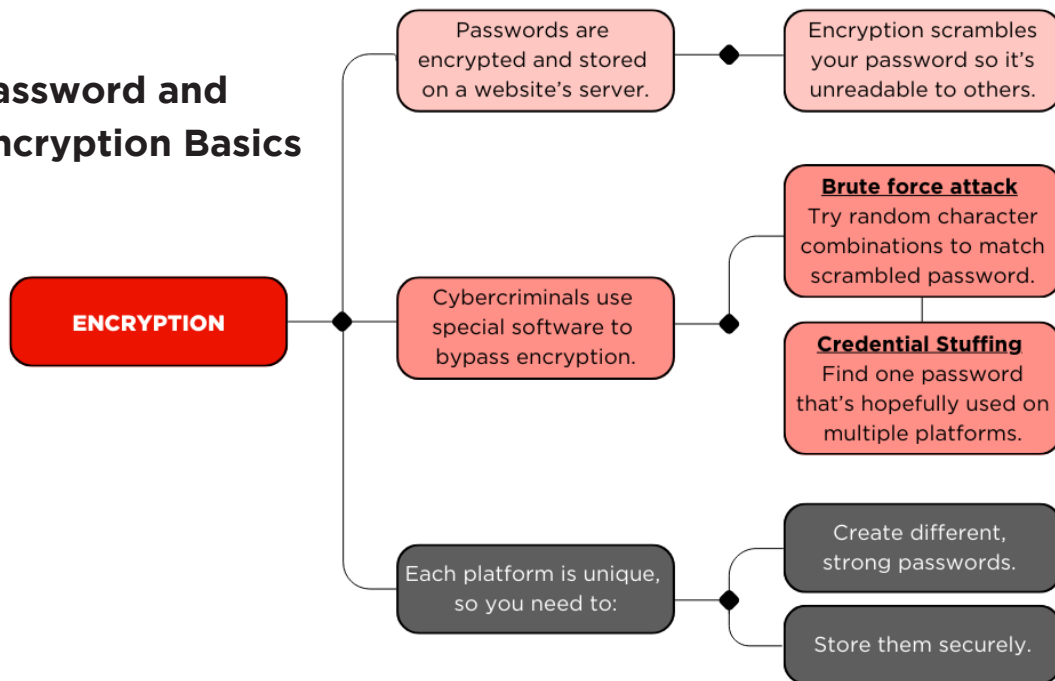

Password and Encryption Basics



Creating and Managing Passwords Securely

Method	Important Details
Single Sign-On (SSO)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Create and manage one strong, complex password.If password is breached all linked accounts are at risk.
Two-Factor Authentication (2FA)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Log in with username and a code sent to your device.
Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Log in with your username, password, and a code sent to your device or a fingerprint or face scan.
Passkeys	<ul style="list-style-type: none">No passwords to remember, safest from cybercriminalsDevice-specific; difficult to recover if device is lost/stolen.
Password Managers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Generates and securely stores your passwords for you.Device-based (Passwords app for iOS, Safari or Google Password Manager feature in the browser)Third-party apps/browser extensions like the ones below
