



Registering for **AARP®** Digital Vault

If you've just purchased or renewed your AARP membership with the Digital Vault add-on, this handout will guide you through the steps to register and set up your Digital Vault account.

Please note that your AARP Digital Vault account is separate from your AARP membership account.

What is Prisdio?

Throughout the sign-up process for the AARP Digital Vault, you might notice a Prisdio logo. Prisdio is the company that provides the secure technology for the AARP Digital Vault service.


Prisdio is also the name of the mobile app you'll download to access and use your AARP Digital Vault on your smartphone.

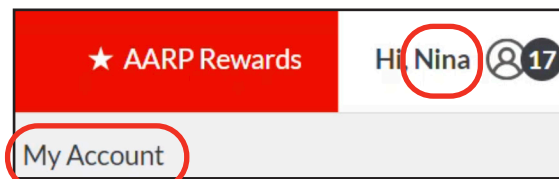

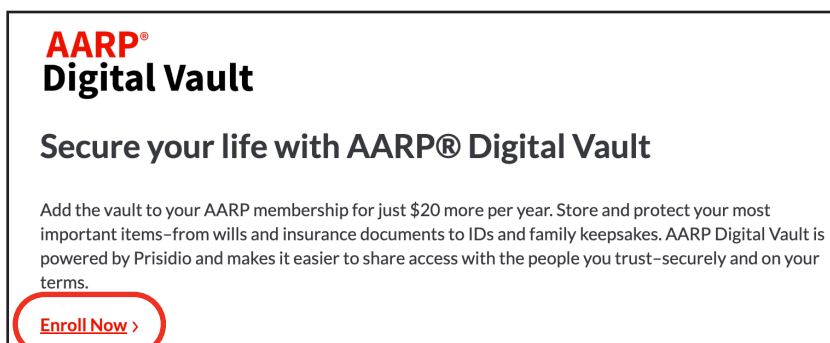
Enrolling in the AARP Digital Vault

You'll need a valid AARP account before you can purchase the AARP Digital Vault product. Make sure you are **logged into your AARP account** on aarp.org in a web browser. Then follow the steps below to enroll in the digital vault.

- 1 After you've signed into aarp.org, select **your name** in the top, right corner to open a dropdown menu. Select **My Account**.



- 2 Scroll down until you find AARP Digital Vault. Select **Enroll Now**.



- 3 A sign-up form will appear on the screen. **At the top of the page, verify the amount that you will be billed annually.**

Complete the form including payment information. Check the box that you have read the subscription agreement.

Select **Enroll Now** to continue.

Registering Your Account, Cont'd

Note: If your AARP member account is new and you've not yet confirmed your email address, you'll see a message that you need to check your email. Find the email and follow the prompts in it to verify your email address and access the AARP Digital Vault login page. Then, continue with the steps below.

- 3 After selecting **Create Account** in step 2 (on the previous page), you'll see the AARP Digital Vault login page.

Enter the email address that was used to create your account in step 2.

Select **Continue**.

- 4 Then, enter the password you established when registering your AARP Digital Vault account.

Select **Continue**.



Adding an Authentication Method

After logging in for the first time, you'll need to choose an authentication method to keep your account safe. This means that for future logins, you'll complete an additional step after entering your password to prove that it's actually you.

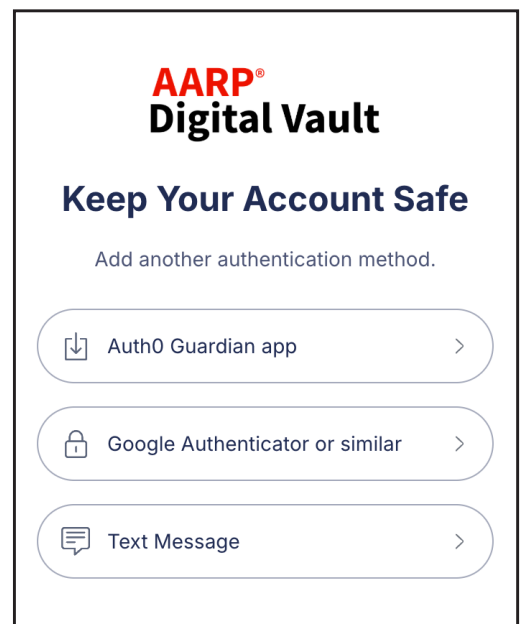
1 Select your preferred authentication method.

- **Auth0 Guardian app:** This method requires you to download the Auth0 Guardian app on your mobile phone and use it to scan a QR code. You then receive a push notification on your phone and have to tap **Allow** to continue.

- **Google Authenticator or similar:** This method allows you to use any popular authentication app such as Google Authenticator, Microsoft Authenticator, etc. You launch the app on your phone, scan the QR code, and enter a one-time code to continue.

- **Text Message:** This method requires you to enter your mobile phone number. You will receive a code in a text message that you must enter to continue.

2 After selecting your authentication method, the next steps will vary based on which method you chose. Follow the prompts on your screen to continue.





Next Steps

Now that you've registered your account, you're ready to start using your AARP Digital Vault. Here are some next steps to help you get started.

1 Download the Prisdio mobile app from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store.
